

INTRODUCTION

The **2019 Jayco Herald Sun Tour**, Stage 4 will be taking place in and around the Mornington Peninsula on **Saturday 2nd February**. The event is starting at the Cape Schanck Lighthouse, finishing at Arthurs Seat and will bring many International cycling stars to the region.

After further consultation and consideration, a decision has been made to alter the initial road closures and access communicated, to provide greater access for residents and business owners within the affected areas. See below.

UPDATED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS CHANGES

Rolling Road Closure Expected Times:

The race will now start 1 hour later than originally planned, commencing at **13:30pm** from the Cape Schanck Lighthouse. The race route between the Cape Schanck Lighthouse and the Arthurs Seat circuit will be conducted under Rolling Road Closure, which will result in minimal impact to the community affected. Please see updated Rolling Road Closure timings on the back page;

CIRCUIT CLOSURE CHANGES:

The Arthurs Seat circuit (red line), will take place on Boundary Road, Arthurs Seat Road, and White Hill Road. Along these roads, temporary road closures will be put in place to manage the safety of the race. Vehicles may access the circuit, in race direction only once the race has safely passed and the official final vehicle (tail end vehicle) is identified. Access will be managed by qualified traffic management at each intersection. Once the 'Police Motorbike' arrives, the intersection will be closed as the race passes.

Please follow the instructions of Traffic Controller and Event Officials.

ARTHURS SEAT ROAD CLOSURE:

Please note, the above closures do not apply to Arthurs Seat Road between the Mornington Peninsula On Ramp and Purves Road. This section will remain closed from 7:30am to 20:00pm to ensure all event infrastructure is set up safely, and we provide a safe environment for the event spectators to enjoy watching the race.

Please plan your journey and allow extra time to travel

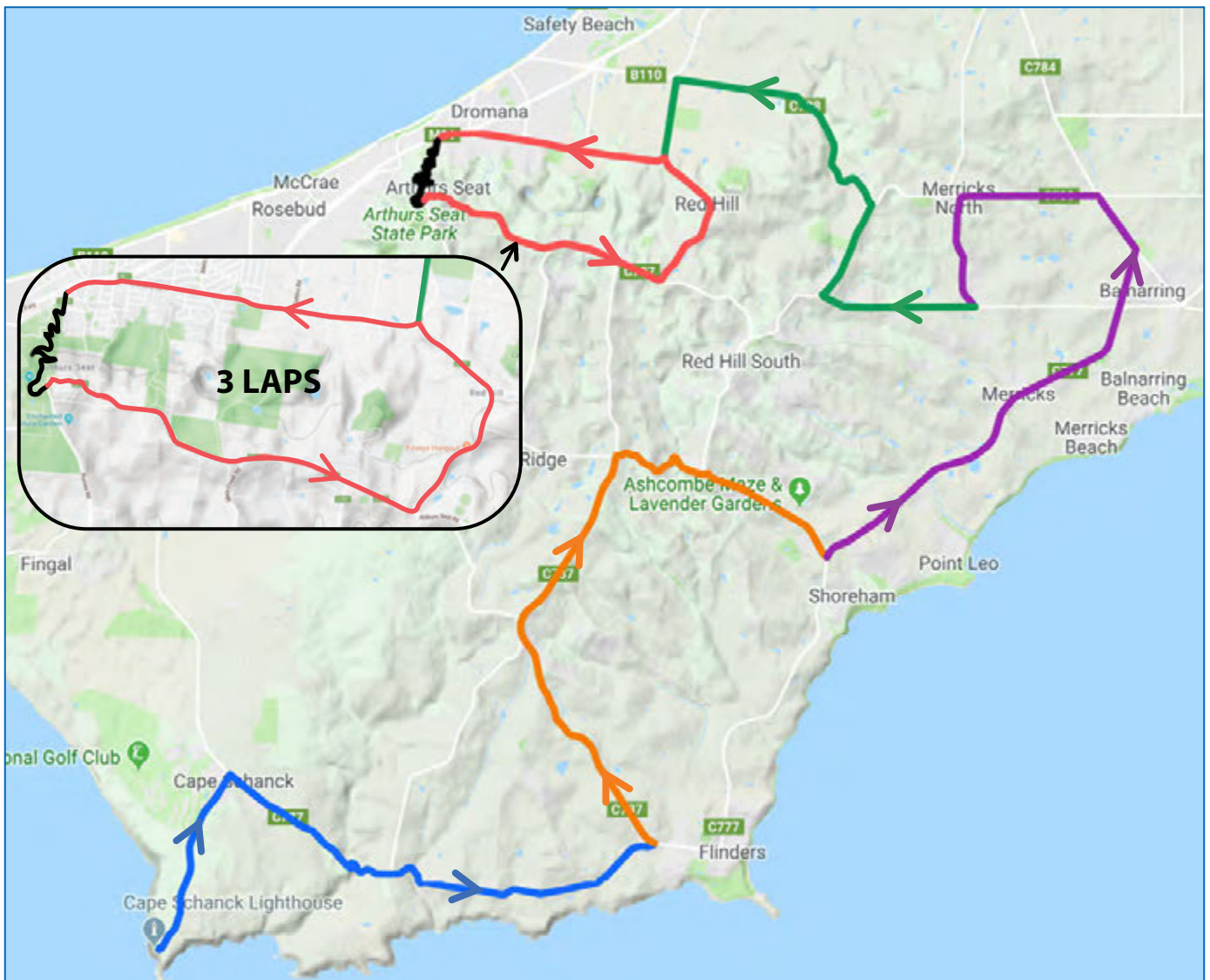

Rolling Road Closure Expected Times:

Please note these times are when the Rolling Road Closure is expected to be along these roads, however the actual Rolling Road Closure is only expected to be in place for 20 minutes. These times below are based on an expected average race speed of 40km/h however this may vary depending on a number of factors such as weather, therefore there could be slight variations on the times below on the day.
