

## INTRODUCTION

On **Saturday 2nd February 2019**, the **Jayco Herald Sun Tour** professional cycling race will conduct a race from Cape Schanck Lighthouse to Arthurs Seat.

With the support of Mornington Peninsula Shire, the tour returns to the region after 2 years away, bringing with it a prestigious field of riders including a number of the world's best teams and riders, including Australia's best current climber, Richie Porte. The event will deliver a significant economic impact for the region and state, and will generate major national and international media exposure, showcasing the beautiful Mornington Peninsula region to Australia and the world.

## TRAFFIC CONDITION CHANGES

To ensure the safety of the riders, spectators and the community, temporary changes to traffic conditions, including road closures will be implemented on the day. Mornington Peninsula Shire will be working with the Jayco Herald Sun Tour Management Team to ensure the control of cyclist, vehicle and pedestrian movement for this event is conducted in a safe manner.

## PARK'n'RIDE

To assist with access to Arthurs Seat we will be offering a **FREE** Park n Ride Service to the Arthurs Seat Eagle Base Station. Park your car in the Dromana Drive-In and board a shuttle bus to the Base Station, where you can then make your way to the top of Arthurs Seat by foot or by purchasing a ticket to ride on the Arthurs Seat Eagle chairlift.

Following the event, the shuttle buses will take you from the Arthurs Seat Eagle Base Station back to the Dromana Drive-In to make your return trip home.
